Enclosed is the Tentative Order to amend Time Schedule Order R5-2015-0003-02 for the City of Jackson (Discharger) Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility). Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order should be submitted to this office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **2 April 2018** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board). Written material submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **2 April 2018** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the proposed Order to amend Time Schedule Order R5-2015-0003-02 at its **5/6 April 2018** Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are enclosed. Please post one (1) copy of the Notice as soon as possible at:

- The nearest city hall or county courthouse,
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and
- The public entrance of the Facility.

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **9 March 2018**. To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative Order package to the Discharger only. Interested persons may download the document from the Central Valley Water
