TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF RED BLUFF, RED BLUFF WASTEWATER RECLAMATION PLANT, RED BLUFF, TEHAMA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES No. CA0078891) and related documents for the City of Red Bluff Wastewater Reclamation Plant in Tehama County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 7 April 2018**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its **31 May, 1 June 2018 Board Meeting**. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 13 March 2018** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed)

Additionally, regulations require that the Discharger publish the Notice of Public Hearing in a local newspaper (e.g. Red Bluff Daily News) for one (1) day. The expense of the publication is to be paid by the Discharger.

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **16 March 2018**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative documents is available on the Central Valley Water Board's web site at
