TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS CITY OF WINTERS WINTERS LANDFILL CLASS III LANDFILL CLOSURE, POSTCLOSURE MAINTENANCE AND CORRECTIVE ACTION YOLO COUNTY

Enclosed for your review is a copy of tentative waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the Winters Landfill in Yolo County. A notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. is also enclosed. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Water Board is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
