TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative rescission order of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order 88-031 for the United States Department of Interior, National Park Service, Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks (National Park Service or Discharger), Clover Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative rescission order must be submitted to this office by **5:00 pm on 11 September 2020**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Central Valley Water Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this date.
