TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALTURAS CLASS III MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL, COUNTY ROAD #60, ALTURAS, MODOC COUNTY

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and a Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Alturas Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, near the community of Alturas, Modoc County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 26 February 2018**. Written materials submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 26 February 2018** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative Order will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its 5/6 April 2018 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. By **29 January 2018**, post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **2 February 2018**.
