RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 95-266

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Central Valley Water Board adopted the following Order which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

- a) Waste Discharge Requirements Order 95-266, adopted on 8 December 1995 prescribes requirements for Crane Mills Paskenta Saw Mill wood processing facility, Tehama County (Site). Mill processing and log deck run off activities and discharges ceased at the Site in 2013/2014. The owner does not plan to restart operations in the near future. As such Crane Mills requested on 20 September 2017 to rescind WDR Order 95-266. Therefore, WDR Order 95-266 is no longer required.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Waste Discharge Requirements Order 95-266 is rescinded.
