### PREPARATION OF NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY

#### Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for In-situ Groundwater Remediation and Discharge of Treated Groundwater to Land

#### TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS AND PERSONS:

The Central Valley Water Board has prepared a draft Notice of Applicability for the former Davis Enterprise site for coverage under General Order No. R5-2015-0012, *Waste Discharge Requirements General Order for In-situ Groundwater Remediation and Discharge of Treated Groundwater to Land*. Coverage under the General Order will allow the Davis Enterprise to add specific compounds to groundwater to break down pollution beneath the property.

#### Project Title:

DAVIS ENTERPRISE GROUNDWATER CLEANUP

#### Project location:

302 G Street, Davis, Yolo County

#### Project Description:

The Davis Enterprise operated a newspaper printing business at 302 G Street in Davis between 1966 and early 2015. Historical records indicate that the Davis Laundry and Cleaners operated a dry cleaning business on the property between the 1930s and the 1960s. The dry cleaning solvent tetrachloroethene (PCE) has been found to pollute groundwater beneath the property. To clean up the groundwater pollution, the Davis Enterprise plans to add bacteria, food-based supplement, and an iron-based compound to the groundwater. The bacteria are naturally occurring species that can completely break down PCE. The iron-based compound can chemically breakdown PCE. The project includes monitoring to ensure the effectiveness of the cleanup.
