NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY OF LAKE PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT EASTLAKE SANITARY LANDFILL LAKE COUNTY

Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative revised waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for Eastlake Sanitary Landfill in Lake County. Also enclosed is a notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 27, section 21730. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
