RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 90-108

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Central Valley Water Board adopted the following Order which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

- a) Waste Discharge Requirements Order 90-108, adopted on 27 April 1990 prescribes requirements for Franklin Construction Inc.'s aggregate processing facility, Butte County (Site). Washwater disposal activities ceased at the Site on 12 May 2017. The owner does not plan to resume operations in the future. Therefore, WDR Order 90-108 is no longer required.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Waste Discharge Requirements Order 90-108 is rescinded.
