NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of the subject Order at a public meeting scheduled for:

The date, time, and location of the public meeting may change after this Notice is issued. A Final Agenda for the meeting will be made available at least 10 days before the meeting. The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed order will be considered, and the anticipated order of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed order. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed order.

Opportunities to Comment

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Order before it votes on whether to adopt the Order.

Written comments or evidence concerning the Order must be submitted by 5:00 pm on 19 October 2026. The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

Oral comments concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain designated parties may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The party subject to the proposed Order is the designated party. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **19 October 2026**. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

Proposed Order

Baldwin Construction Co., dba Knife River Constructions owns and operates the Hallwood Plant (Facility) located at 2965 Hooper Road in Yuba County. The Facility is currently regulated under Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) R5-2010-0124, adopted on 10 December 2010. The Facility is an aggregate mine that generates wastewater from washing mined aggregate. The Facility mines the aggregate from an excavation pond, directs the aggregate to a processing plant for crushing, screening, and washing. Wastewater is then discharged to a settling/recycling pond where the

wastewater is recycled back to the plant for reuse. The proposed Order would authorize a flow limit not to exceed 2.0 million gallons per day (mgd) as a monthly average to an active settling/recycling pond. In addition, the Order would set a performance-based salinity action level of 700 micromho per centimeter ($\mu\text{mhos/cm}$) for electrical conductivity as an annual average for each settling/recycling pond active during the monitoring period.
