TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is the tentative Time Schedule Order for County of Lake, City of Clearlake, and City of Lakeport (Permittees) for their municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4) located within the urban areas of their jurisdictions. Any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the proposed Order should be submitted to this office via email to **RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov**, no later than 5:00 p.m. on **25 November 2019** in order for us to give them full consideration prior to the meeting of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board). Written material submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **25 November 2019** will not

be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

A Notice of Public Hearing concerning the proposed Order is also enclosed. If possible, please post the Notice of Public Hearing on the Permittee's website.

If substantial written comments are not received by **25 November 2019**, the Executive Officer will issue the Order after the close of the comment period, in accordance with Central Valley Water Board Resolution R5-2018-0057 and Water Code section 13223, which delegate the authority to the Executive Officer to issue or modify time schedule orders.

Any member of the public may request an oral hearing before the Executive Officer. If no oral hearing is requested, the public comment period, and the Executive Officer's review of the administrative record, including any written comments, shall constitute the public hearing (see California Water Code section 13385, subdivision (j)(3)(C)(ii)(II)). Based on comments received, the Executive Officer may decide to hold an oral hearing or the matter will be considered at the Central Valley Water Board meeting scheduled for **20/21 February 2020**.
