## TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2016-0028-01 for Lathrop Consolidated Treatment Facility in San Joaquin County. The Central Valley Region Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will be considering adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 21/22 June 2023 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by **5 p.m. on 8 June 2023**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative Rescission Order has been sent only to the Discharger.
