TENTATIVE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CENTRAL VALLEY REGION ORDER R5-2023-XXXX RESCINDING VARIOUS WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the following reasons:

CITY OF LATHROP, LATHROP CONSOLIDATED TREATMENT FACILITY, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R5-2016-0028-01

Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2016-0028, adopted on 21 April 2016 and amended on 6 April 2018 (R5-2016-0068-01), prescribes requirements for the Lathrop Consolidated Treatment Facility in San Joaquin County. The Discharger is ceasing discharges of wastewater to land to maximize the beneficial use of recycled water mainly through landscape irrigation and construction uses. The remaining effluent will be discharged via the surface water outfall to the San Joaquin River. The distribution and use of recycled water is regulated under the State Water Resources Control Board Order No. WQ 2016-0068-DDW-R5017; therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order No. R5-2016-0068-01 and the corresponding Monitoring and Reportion Program (MRP) Order No. R5-2016-0068-02.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Order is rescinded as of the date of this Order.
