Amended waste discharge requirements (WDRs) are tentatively being issued to Lehigh West, LLC, as the new owner, and Lehigh Southwest Cement Company as the new operator of the Calaveras Cement Plant (Facility) located at 2965 Pool Station Road, San Andreas, CA 95249 in Calaveras County. The name of Facility is to change from Calaveras Cement Plant to Lehigh Southwest Cement Company (f/k/a Calaveras Cement Company) - Former Calaveras Cement Plant. The information for the amendment of the WDR Order will be added to the uncontested agenda for the **8/9 December 2022** Board meeting.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 27 October 2022**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

This notice is being issued for 30-day public comment period on **28 September 2022**. Comments are due by **5:00 p.m. on 27 October 2022**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 27 October 2022** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record absent a ruling by the Board Chair. Any person requesting to submit late materials must demonstrate good cause for the late submission, and the Chair must find that accepting the late submission will not prejudice the Central Valley Water Board or any Designated Party.
