RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 97-134; MARIPOSA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; MARIPOSA PINES WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; MARIPOSA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES

Enclosed is a tentative Rescission Order to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 97-134 for Mariposa County Public Works Department's Mariposa Pines Wastewater Treatment Facility (Facility). The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 18/19 February 2021 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 8 January 2021**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
