RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown.

**MARIPOSA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; MARIPOSA PINES
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER 97-134; MARIPOSA COUNTY**

Waste Discharge Requirements Order (WDRs) Order 97-134, adopted on 20 June 1997, prescribes requirements for the Mariposa County Public Works Department (Discharger), Mariposa Pines Treatment Facility (WWTF) for a daily maximum discharge flow of 5,000 gallons per day (gpd) to leach fields. On 16 July 2020, a Report of Waste Discharge was submitted by Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group, on behalf of the Discharger, requesting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order). On 9 December 2020, a Notice of Applicability was issued to the Discharger for coverage under the General Order. The Discharger was assigned enrollee number 2014-0153-DWQ-R5350. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind WDRs Order 97-134.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Order is rescinded.
