The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

**Oral comments** concerning the Order must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide their comments. Certain **designated parties** may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The party's subject to the proposed Order are designated parties. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water no later than 5:00 p.m. on 3 November 2025. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

## Proposed Order

If adopted, Order R5-2025-XXXX will revise current waste discharge requirements for the discharge of wastewater to land from operations at the Reedley Winery and Distillery located at 8418 South Lac Jac Avenue, Parlier, Ca 93648. The Reedley Winery and Distillery is owned and operated by O'Neill Beverages Company, LLC (Discharger) and is currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2014-0045. The current Order authorizes the seasonal operational discharge of up to 0.61 million gallons per day (mgd) and 80 million gallons per year of winery waste to 189 acres of adjacent land application areas (LAAs). The proposed WDR Order

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authorizes expanded land application on up to 325 acres of adjacent LAA and the following:

- Annual flow limit of 85.85 million gallons.
- Monthly average flow limit of 0.61 million gallons per day (mgd).
- Performance Based Salinity limit of 2,000 mg/L.
- Biochemical oxygen demand cycle average loading to the LAA not to exceed
   50 lbs/ac/day in Fields A-East and A-West or 150 lbs/ac/day for remaining LAA fields.
- Prohibition on introducing high salinity waste streams (i.e., boiler blow down, water softener regenerant, etc.) to the discharge.
- Preparation and implementation of a Wastewater and Nutrient Management Plan.
- Compliance with the Salt and Nitrate Control Programs.
- Effluent, LAA, groundwater, and soil monitoring.
