TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2015-0104, PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, KERCKHOFF DAM LOW LEVEL OUTLET GATE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, MADERA COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements for the Kerckhoff Dam Low Level Outlet Gate Replacement Project (Project) in Madera County. A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its **31 May/1 June 2018** Board Meeting. For the tentative rescission order to be included with the adopted orders, you must post the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing by **27 February 2018** at the following locations:

- The Project site;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

To verify the Notice of Public Hearing has been posted, a completed copy of the enclosed Proof of Posting form must be sent to our office by **6 March 2018**.

Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5 p.m. on 29 March 2018**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative document will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.
