**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will consider adoption of a Resolution to approve the proposed Revised Local Agency Management Program (LAMP) for Placer County at a public meeting scheduled for:

The date, time, and location of the public meeting may change after this Notice is issued. A Final Agenda for the meeting will be made available at least 10 days before the meeting. The Final Agenda will provide the location and format of the meeting, the anticipated date that the proposed Resolution will be considered, and the anticipated Resolution of all agenda items; however, the Board may consider agenda items out of their listed Resolution. The agenda materials may also include staff revisions to the proposed Resolution.

The Central Valley Water Board will consider oral and written comments on the proposed Resolution before it votes on whether to adopt the Resolution.

The Board Chair may refuse to admit any comments or evidence received after the comment period unless the submitting party provides a reasonable explanation for why the submission is late and the Board Chair determines that admission of the late submission would not prejudice any other party.

**Oral comments** concerning the Resolution must be presented at the scheduled public meeting. Interested parties are generally allowed up to three minutes each to provide

their comments. Certain **designated parties** may provide longer comments and have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, cross-examine opposing witnesses, impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence against him or her. The party subject to the proposed Resolution is a designated party. Any other party may request recognition as a designated party by submitting a written statement of how they are directly affected by the discharge(s) to be regulated and why they would like to be considered a designated party. Such requests must be submitted to Central Valley Water no later than **5:00 p.m. on 8 September 2025**. Instructions on how to provide oral comments will be included in the Final Agenda for the meeting.

### **Proposed Resolution**

The State Water Resources Control Board's *Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment* Systems (the "OWTS Policy") regulates small domestic OWTS. The OWTS Policy allows for the continued use of OWTS under Local Agency oversight, establishes minimum risk-based standards, and requires Local Agencies to assess water quality. Local Agencies may either directly implement the conservative low-risk standards in the OWTS Policy or develop a LAMP. When a local agency within the Central Valley Region prepares a LAMP, the Central Valley Water Board is required to review the LAMP to determine whether it is protective of human health and water quality.

On 7 April 2017, the Central Valley Water Board approved a LAMP for Placer County. On 11 June 2025, Placer County Environmental Health Division submitted a revised LAMP for the Board's approval. The Board staff has reviewed the revised LAMP and has concluded that it is consistent with the OWTS Policy. The Board staff has proposed that the Central Valley Water Board consider a Resolution approving the revised LAMP.

To conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the proposed Resolution will be sent only to Placer County.
