Enclosed for your review is a copy of the tentative revision to waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for the Auburn Landfill in Placer County. This item, previously noticed for the February 2018 Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) meeting, is being re-noticed at the request of the Discharger to allow more time for review and comment. A revised notice of public hearing (NOPH) to interested parties pursuant to §21730 of Title 27, California Code of Regulations, Section 20005 et seq. (Title 27) is also enclosed. The enclosed NOPH describes the date, time, and place that the Central Valley Water Board is scheduled to have a hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative WDRs.
