ORDER R5-2020-XXXX

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

**SIERRA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT; FOOTHILL MIDDLE SCHOOL
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. 94-107, FRESNO COUNTY**

Waste Discharge Requirements Order 94-107, adopted on 22 April 1994, regulates the discharge of disinfected wastewater from the Sierra Foothill Elementary/Middle School wastewater treatment facility (Facility) at 29147 Auberry Road near Prather in Fresno County. Order 94-107 prescribes requirements for the discharge of up to 31,500 gallons per day (gpd) as a monthly average to lined ponds and a spray field. On 6 March 2020 the Sierra Unified School District (Discharger) submitted a Report of Waste Discharge for coverage under State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order). On 3 July 2020, a Notice of Applicability was issued for the Facility (enrollee number 2014-0153-DWQ-R5337) enrolling the Facility under the General Order upon rescission of Order 94-107. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 94-107.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Orders are rescinded.
