RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2016-0034

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board), finds that the Central Valley Water Board adopted the following Order which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

- a) Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2016-0034, adopted on 21 April 2016 prescribes requirements for the Anderson Biomass Plant's cogeneration facility, Shasta County (Site). Wastewater disposal activities ceased at the Site on 13 October 2013 and the facility did not operate under this order. The owner does not plan to resume operations in the future. Therefore, WDR Order R5-2016-0034 is no longer required.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2016-0034 is rescinded.
