TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER R5-2012-0126 FOR JERRY AND ERIKA WRIGHT LIVING TRUST, VILLA TOSCANO WINERY, AMADOR COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Rescission Order to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order R5-2012-0126 for Villa Toscano Winery in Amador County. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board will consider adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 22/23 April 2021 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative WDRs rescission must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 11 March 2021**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

To conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative Rescission Order has been sent only to the Discharger.
