TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. 85-312; CALMAT COMPANY DBA VULCAN MATERIALS COMPANY, ERIN MARSHA TALBERT, AND EARL P. KNOBLOCH; RIVER ROCK SAND AND GRAVEL FACILITY; FRESNO COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative order rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order 85-312 for the CalMat Company dba Vulcan Materials Company's (Vulcan) River Rock Sand and Gravel Facility (Facility) in Fresno County. The Facility was operated by Vulcan on property owned by Erin Marsha Talbert and Earl Knobloch (collectively referred to as Dischargers). The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 14/15 October 2021 meeting. Any comments or recommendations you or others may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted in writing to this office by **5 p.m. on 25 August 2021**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.

In order to conserve paper and reduce mailing costs, a paper copy of the tentative Rescission Order has been sent only to the Dischargers.
