TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 87-046; GOLDEN STATE YMCA; YMCA CAMP TULEQUOIA AT SEQUOIA LAKE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; FRESNO COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES

Enclosed is a tentative Rescission Order to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 87-046 for the Golden State YMCA, YMCA Camp Tulequoia at Sequoia Lake Wastewater Treatment Facility (Facility) in Fresno County. The Central Valley Water Board will be considering adoption of the tentative Rescission Order at its 18/19 February 2021 meeting. Any written comments or evidence you may have concerning the tentative Rescission Order must be submitted to this office by **5:00 p.m. on 18 December 2020**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
