TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R5-2021-XXXX

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Order, which is no longer applicable for the reasons shown.

**GOLDEN STATE YMCA; YMCA CAMP TULEQUOIA AT SEQUOIA LAKE
WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. 87-046, FRESNO COUNTY**

Waste Discharge Requirements Order 87-046, adopted on 27 March 1987, prescribes requirements for the Golden State YMCA (Discharger) YMCA Camp Tulequoia at Sequoia Lake Wastewater Treatment Facility (Facility) for an average daily discharge of 4,250 gallons per day to onsite evaporation/percolation ponds. The Facility provides service for a summer camp, which hosts between 25 and 200 visitors at a time during the summer months. On 13 November 2020, a Notice of Applicability was issued for the Facility (enrollee number 2014-0153-DWQ-R5351) enrolling the Facility under the State Water Resources Control Board Water Quality Order 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems* (General Order). Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order 87-046.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Order is rescinded.
