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Public Notice:
Proposed No Further Action Determination

AAMCO Transmission and Total Car Care

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) invites public comment regarding the intent of the Board to grant regulatory closure for the leaking underground storage tank (UST) case at the AAMCO Transmission and Total Car Care located at 207 Kenroy Lane in Roseville, California (Site).

In 1983, Brandco, the current property owner, removed a single UST from the Site. In March 2019, a geophysical survey identified the former UST location and soil and groundwater samples collected on-Site contained petroleum hydrocarbons. In December 2019, the property owner evaluated the extent of petroleum hydrocarbon impacts in soil and groundwater and concluded the dissolved petroleum hydrocarbon plume length is less than 100 feet in length and the nearest existing water supply well or surface water body is greater than 250 feet from the defined plume boundary. Soil and groundwater samples did not contain benzene or methyl tert butyl ether (MTBE) above laboratory reporting limits. No free product was identified in groundwater. The on-Site building does not overlay the impacted area.

Based on Site data, Geographic Services Inc and Brusca Associates prepared a request for regulatory closure on behalf of Brandco. In that request, GSI and Brusca indicates that Site data meet the closure criteria presented in the State Water Resource Control Board's *Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy*.

Central Valley Water Board staff reviewed the request for regulatory closure and, based on the data compiled to date, believe there is merit to this request. As such, the Central Valley Water Board is conducting a public participation comment period that allows interested parties to comment on the proposed case closure. This Public Notice is being provided to you because your property, place of residence, or work is located within approximately 200 feet of the Site as shown on the attached map. After September 25, 2020, Central Valley Water Board staff intends to complete its closure review process and close this former leaking UST case.
