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**Public Notice:
Proposed No Further Action Determination**

**ARCO No. 2094
1399 West Wood Street
Willows, CA**

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Board) invites public comment regarding the intent of the Board to grant regulatory closure for the leaking underground storage tank (UST) case at ARCO No. 2094 located at 1399 West Wood Street in Willows, California (Site).

In 1988, Atlantic Richfield Company (ARCO), a BP West Coast Products, LLC (BP) affiliated company unintentionally punctured a 6,000-gallon capacity UST and released approximately 5,000 gallons of gasoline. In 1989, ARCO removed its USTs and installed a new UST system. Between 1993 and 2021, ARCO assessed petroleum hydrocarbon impacts in soil, soil gas, and groundwater collecting samples and conducting routine monitoring. ARCO treated petroleum hydrocarbon impacted groundwater at the Site and removed approximately 5,200 gallons of petroleum hydrocarbons through remediation activities. Arcadis concludes the extent of petroleum hydrocarbons remaining in soil and groundwater beneath the Site is defined and relatively stable.

Based on Site data, Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) prepared a request for regulatory closure on behalf of BP, the Site property owner. In that request, Arcadis indicates that Site data meet the closure criteria presented in the State Water Resource Control Board's *Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy*.

Central Valley Water Board staff reviewed the request for regulatory closure and, based on the data compiled to date, believe there is merit to this request. As such, a public participation comment period that allows interested parties to comment on the proposed case closure is being conducted. This Public Notice is being provided to you because your property, place of residence, or work is located within approximately 200 feet of the Site as shown on the attached map. After November 5, 2021, Central Valley Water Board staff intends to complete its closure review process and close this former leaking UST case.

Public Comment Period: September 6 through November 5, 2021
