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Public Notice:
Proposed No Further Action Determination

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Board) invites public comment regarding the intent of the Board to grant regulatory closure for the leaking underground storage tank (UST) case at Lincoln Regional Airport located at 1480 Flightline Drive in Lincoln, California (Site).

Between August 2021 and March 2022, the City of Lincoln and NV5 removed two 12,000-gallon fiberglass USTs from the Site and restored Site conditions. In November 2021, the City of Lincoln removed approximately 480 tons petroleum hydrocarbon impacted pea gravel from excavations and disposed of material off-Site. Soil samples collected within the UST basin contained petroleum hydrocarbons. In February and March 2022, NV5 excavated an additional 450 tons of native soils and collected confirmation soil samples which did not contain detectable concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbons, with the exception on a single sample at 5 feet below ground surface under the asphalt runway.

Based on Site data, NV5, prepared a request for regulatory closure on behalf of the City of Lincoln, the Site property owner. In that request, NV5 indicates that Site data meet the closure criteria presented in the State Water Resource Control Board's *Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy*.

Central Valley Water Board staff reviewed the request for regulatory closure and, based on the data compiled to date, believe there is merit to this request. As such, a public participation comment period that allows interested parties to comment on the proposed case closure is being conducted. This Public Notice is being provided to you because your property, place of residence, or work is located within approximately 200 feet of the Site as shown on the attached map. After March 28, 2023, Central Valley Water Board staff intends to complete its closure review process and close this former leaking UST case.
