Eastern S/J ... appendix E (definitions)

#48 "apr 200" probably means April 2000

#42 toxicity probably should include epigenetic markers in def.

nutrient ... says "elemental" which leaves out phosphorus. P is taken up as a molecular ion, not as an element.
water is not a nutrient, according to NOP rules.

Note on antidegradation policy. 1968 US Congress passed antidegradation laws. These were incorporated into Clean Water Act. These give special consideration to Upper Mokelumne River watershed that is not covered by state anti-degradation policies.
