**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Filing Fee No Effect Determination
Region-wide Municipal and Domestic Supply Evaluation Process Basin Plan
Amendment**

Based on a review of the project referenced above, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has determined that for the purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees (Fish and G. Code, § 711.4, subd.
