NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING Concerning

Amendments to the Water Quality Control Plans for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and the Tulare Lake Basin to Incorporate Revisions to the Salt and Nitrate Control Program

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Central Valley Water Board will accept comments regarding the development of amendments (the "Proposed Amendments") to the Water Quality Control Plans for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and the Tulare Lake Basin (Basin Plans). The Proposed Amendments will revise the Central Valley-wide Salt and Nitrate Control Program, detailed in Central Valley Water Board Resolution R5-2018-0034, to be consistent with the directives of the State Water Resource Control Board Resolution 2019-0057.
