ORDER NO. 77-61

RESCISSION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER NO. 76-67 CITY OF BANNING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITE Riverside County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

- On November 18, 1976, the Board adopted Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 76-67 against the City of Banning, requiring the City to cleanup and abate the discharge of Group 2 waste materials onto a 60 acre parcel of land southeast of Banning in NW%, Section 14, T13S, RIE, SBB&M. Said Order contained a final compliance date of April 28, 1977.
- 2. The water quality control problems which necessitated the adoption of Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 76-67 have been resolved to the satisfaction of the Board.
- 3. Enforcement actions, as specified in Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 76-67, are no longer required.
- 4. The Board forwarded timely notice by mail to City of Banning, and to all affected persons, explaining its intent to rescind same.
- 5. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 76-67.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 76-67 is hereby rescinded.
