ORDER NO. 79-39

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders containing waste discharge requirements apply to waste discharge facilities which have ceased discharging, were never constructed, or have been connected to a community sewerage system.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders who submitted the original reports of waste discharge, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescinding of the below-listed Orders.
