RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:


1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that have discharges that are less than 15,000 gallons-per-day and are now considered insignificant, or are no longer in use, or have been connected to the local municipal sewerage system, or were never constructed.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
