RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that have discharges that are less than 15,000 gallonsper-day and are now considered insignificant, or are no longer in use, or have been connected to the local municipal sewerage system, or were never constructed.

- 3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
