The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, adopts the attached "Memorandum of Understanding Between California Desert District and the Yuma District, U.S. Bureau of Land Management, and California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin which memorandum is signed by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management Districts on October 30, 1984, and the Board hereby orders the Board's Executive Officer to sign said memorandum of understanding.
