ORDER NO. 85-25

RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 84-58 AGAINST CITY OF BRAWLEY Imperial County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

- 1. The Board adopted on June 20, 1984, Cease and Desist Order No. 84-58, requiring the City of Brawley to submit certain information to the Board within 90 days of the promulgation of revised secondary treatment regulations by the Administrator of EPA. Accordingly, the City submitted a letter dated December 18, 1984, stating that the existing wastewater treatment plant effluent quality complies with EPA's revised secondary treatment regulations as set forth in 40 CFR Parts 122 and 133, dated September 20, 1984. (treatment equivalent to secondary treatment)
- 2. The Board adopted revised waste discharge requirements for this discharge in Order No. 85-17 (NPDES No. CA0104523), dated January 23, 1985. Said requirements are EPA's secondary treatment standards for waste stabilization ponds in regard to suspended solids and BOD₅ effluent limitations (treatment equivalent to secondary treatment). Board staff review of self monitoring reports submitted by the City over a 12 month period shows monitored constituents to be within the required effluent limitations.
- 3. Enforcement actions as specified in Cease and Desist Order No. 84-58 are no longer required.
- 4. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to the dischargers and to all other affected persons and agencies, explaining its intent to rescind Cease and Desist Order No. 84-58.
- 5. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of Cease and Desist Order No. 84-58.
- 6. This enforcement action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Section 21,000 et seq.,) in accordance with Section 15121, Chapter 3, Title 14, California Administrative Code.

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Cease and Desist Order No. 84-58 is hereby rescinded.
