RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that receive a discharge of less than 15,000 gallons-per-day, which is ordinarily considered as below the level at which waste discharge requirements are needed to be prescribed, or have had the requirements updated.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Orders, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
