## RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

- The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that receive a discharge of less than 15,000 gallons-per-day, which is ordinarily considered as below the level at which waste discharge requirements are needed to be prescribed, or have had the requirements updated.
- 2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
- 3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Orders, and requesting timely comments.
- 4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
