RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

- The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that are no longer in use or were never constructed or have a discharge of less than 15,000 gallons-per-day, which is ordinarily below the amount necessary for waste discharge requirements.
