**RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that are no longer in use or were never constructed.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's consideration of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
