

ORDER NO. 91-021

RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

- 1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that are discharging less than 15,000 gallonsper-day into subsurface sewage disposal systems, or were never constructed.
- 2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
- 3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
- 4. The Board at a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
