RESOLUTION NO. 93-062

APPROVING THE INITIAL STUDY,
APPROVING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND
MITIGATION MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR
THE ISSUANCE OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR

VENTURA COASTAL CORPORATION INDIO PROCESSING PLANT North of Indio - Riverside County

- WHEREAS, On 29 November 1990 and 11 February 1992, Ventura Coastal Corporation, Indio Processing Plant submitted an updated Report of Waste Discharge to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (hereafter Board), to: 1) increase the quantity of wastewater to be discharged; 2) change its irrigation system to drip irrigation; 3) change the location of irrigation in Riverside County; and
- WHEREAS, The proposed project is on a property owned and located as follows: Ventura Coastal Corporation - W 1/2 of Section 31, T4S, R8E, and the W 1/2 of Section 5 of T5S, R8E, SBB&M; and
- WHEREAS, The Board has assumed the lead agency role for this project under the California Environmental Quality Act and has conducted an Initial Study in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15063, entitled Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Initial Study concluded that the project as proposed would not have a significant effect on the environment and a Negative Declaration and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program would be prepared, the Initial Study concluded that the project as proposed would not have any significant impact on fish or wildlife or their habitats, and the Initial Study stated that waste discharge requirements would be formulated to mitigate any potentially adverse environmental impacts through prohibitions, specification, provisions, and monitoring and reporting requirements and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program; and
- WHEREAS, Copies of the Initial Study, proposed Negative Declaration, and tentative waste discharge requirements were transmitted to all agencies and persons known to be interested in this matter; and
- WHEREAS, The comments received have been addressed; and

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WHEREAS, The Board considered all testimony and evidence at a public hearing held on 30 June 1993 in Indian Wells, California, and good cause was found to approve the Initial Study, approve a Negative Declaration, and approve the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, approves the Initial Study, approves the Negative Declaration and approves the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for adoption of waste discharge requirements to: 1) increase the quantity of wastewater to be discharged; 2) change its irrigation system to drip irrigation; 3) change the location of irrigation in Riverside County at the site described herein.
