- 3. List any proposed changes in the sewage disposal facilities during the upcoming year.
- 4. Explain any problems in the sewage treatment and disposal system during the preceding year.
- 5. The oxidation basin shall be sampled (if wastewater is contained therein) annually during November each year. The samples shall be analyzed for the following:
