This letter is in response to the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R7-2008-0016- for Mandatory Minimum Penalty; an action against the Coachella Sanitary District Municipal Wastewater Treatment Plant, Riverside County. The City of Coachella acknowledges the Administrative Civil liability and does not contest the findings included in your correspondence dated August 27, 2008. The district intends to use a portion of the civil liability for a Supplemental Environmental Project listed as follows.

- An Overflow Drain Project for one of our City passive parks (Chichenitza/Puerto Escondido/Agua Blanca) - Vertical Drain systems to 2 Drywells systems will be assembled to address the local flooding issue. Total cost for the project will be \$59,942.30. A detailed estimate herewith is enclosed.
- Construction of Catch Basins for Valley Road Drainage System- Construct and connect
 catch basins to existing storm drain on Valley Road to address street flooding impacting
 health and safety of residents. The total estimated cost for the project is \$64,020.00.

PASSIVE PARK DRAINAGE REMEDIATION PROJECT AT TRACT 30684 CHICHENITZA/PUERTO ESCONDIDO/AGUA BLANCA- COACHELLA, CALIFORNIA

HISTORY:

In the past the drainage system in two passive parks, located in Tract 30684 have failed due to the high clay content of the upper layers of the soil. This condition leaves standing water leading to insect issues and makes the park unsuitable for use as a passive park.

PROJECT:

The City of Coachella will install six vertical drains, as shown on the attached exhibit, the vertical drains will allow the water to drain into the sandy layer between clay layers and eventually captured by the CVWD agriculture drainage system.

The system will resolve the above mentioned issues that currently exist.

SCHEDULE:

Plans and specifications are being prepared and the project and will be advertised in December 2008 and work will be completed by July 31, 2009.



The system will resolve the above mentioned issues that currently exist.


