Reason for rescission: The transfer of influent flows from CVWD's Water Reclamation Plant No. 9 (WRP9) in Palm Desert to its Mid-Valley Water Reclamation Plant No. 4 in Thermal took place in June 2015. This was followed by demolition and permanent decommissioning of WRP9 in early 2016.
