The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Colorado River Basin Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment proposed Order R7 2018-0009, which will serve as an NPDES permit and WDRs for the Date Gardens Mobile Home Park Wastewater Treatment Plant. BACKGROUND

Date Gardens Asset Partners, L.P. owns and Hector Munoz d/b/a Munoz Wastewater Monitoring Services operates the Date Gardens Mobile Home Park Wastewater Treatment Plant, located at 1020 West Evan Hewes Highway, El Centro, California. The current total design capacity of the wastewater treatment plant is 0.02 million gallons per day (MGD). The treatment system consists of two activated sludge treatment plants operated in parallel. Sewage is conveyed from the mobile home park by gravity through bar screens to a wet well with two openings located adjacent to the package plants. Sewage is pumped up to the package plants using two submersible sewage pumps. From the wet wells, two pumps convey wastewater through a rotary drum screen, then to an aeration basin. Following the aeration basin, wastewater is pumped to a clarifier for settling. Return activated sludge is pumped from the clarifier to the aeration basin. Waste activated sludge is pumped to the activated sludge unit (Unit 1). Clarifier effluent, e.g. overflow, is then directed through two sand filters in parallel, and then through an ultraviolet (UV) disinfection system prior to being directed through a final effluent channel and weir box. The wastewater treatment plant services a population of approximately 250 individuals among 72 mobile home spaces in Imperial Valley. The subject facility produces wastewater that is 100% domestic, with no industrial or commercial discharge. Wastewater is discharged from Discharge Point 001 to Rice Drain No. 3, a water of the United States.

The discharge is currently regulated by an NPDES Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements (NPDES Permit No. CA0104841, Order R7-2013-0009), which was adopted on May 16, 2013 and has been administratively extended. A report of waste discharge was filed and an application submitted for reissuance of the WDRs and NPDES permit on December 18, 2017.

The Colorado River Basin Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received. If written comments to the Colorado River Basin Water Board are not timely submitted, late comments will not be accepted if doing so would prejudice any party in accordance with section 648.4, title 23 of the California Code of Regulations.

HEARING PROCEDURE

Affected stakeholders and other interested persons are invited to attend and express their views on this matter at the public hearing, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. In addition, to ensure accuracy of the record, the Colorado River Basin Water Board requests that any speakers who have prepared written statements for oral presentation at the hearing submit those statements to Colorado River Basin Water Board staff before or during the hearing.

Those who wish to speak at the hearing will be asked to fill out a speaker request card and provide it to Colorado River Basin Water Board staff. Comments from the public will be limited to three (3) minutes per person. Any person planning to make a presentation to the Colorado River Basin Water Board that requires the use of visual aids (such as overheads, slides, or video projector) should contact the assigned staff person to make arrangements before the meeting date in order to avoid unnecessary delays during the meeting. Where speakers can be grouped by affiliation or interest, such groups will be expected to select a spokesperson and not be repetitive.
