**NOTICE OF REGIONAL WATER BOARD WORKSHOP  
ON REGIONAL STRATEGIC PLANNING  
AND PRESENTATION OF UPDATED ENFORCEMENT POLICY**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Regional Water Board), will be meeting for presentation by staff from the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on the updated State Water Board Enforcement Policy. Following the presentation, the Regional Water Board will be conducting a workshop to discuss implementation strategies for its strategic goals. The meeting and workshop on the matter are scheduled as follows:

A quorum of the Regional Water Board members may be present at the meeting and workshop. However, no specific items of business will be discussed and no formal Board action will be taken at the meeting and workshop.

On November 17, 2009, the State Water Board adopted an updated Enforcement Policy. The updated Enforcement Policy establishes a statewide approach for prioritizing violations of Board orders, regulations, and water quality control policies for enforcement, and a step-wise process for assessing administrative civil liability to ensure enforcement consistency among the Water Boards. As noted above, staff from the State Water Board will present the updated Enforcement Policy during the meeting.

The workshop is a continuation of a previous strategic planning workshop held on November 19, 2009, during which the Regional Water Board established its Regional goals. During this workshop, the Regional Water Board members will discuss strategies to increase recycling/reuse of wastewater in the Region 30% by 2017. As with the previous workshop, this workshop will be facilitated by academic staff from UC Davis Extension.

Even though the workshop is designed to encourage and facilitate a high level of interaction among the Regional Water Board members for establishing strategies to implement its Regional goals, public input into this effort is also strongly encouraged and welcomed.
