NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Regional Board will consider proposed Waste Discharge Requirements for Ram Power, Inc., Board Order R7-2010-0008, regarding the Orita Geothermal Exploration Project, located approximately 11 miles east of Brawley, Imperial County.

The above Waste Discharge Requirements regulate wellfield mud sumps/containment basins associated with proposed Orita Geothermal Exploration Project. The project proposes to drill geothermal exploration wells in the vicinity of the East Brawley Known Geothermal Resource Area (East Brawley KGRA).

The Regional Board will consider adopting the Proposed Board Order, R7-2010-0008, during a Public Hearing that will commence at the time and place indicated below:

The Regional Board will be receiving and reviewing written comments during the public comment period, which begins February 11, 2010, and ends March 13, 2010. Persons wishing to submit written comments on the Proposed Order are requested to do so as soon as possible, but not later than March 13, 2010. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views on this matter at the Public Hearing.

The Proposed Board Order and related documents, including the proposed *Report of Waste Discharge*, may be inspected and copied at the Regional Board office. Anyone wishing to contest a consent item on the agenda is expected to appear in person at the Board meeting and explain to the Board the reason the item is being contested.
